Don't forget that it is half term from Monday 18th February to Friday 22 February and the school will be closed. We re-open on Monday 25th February!



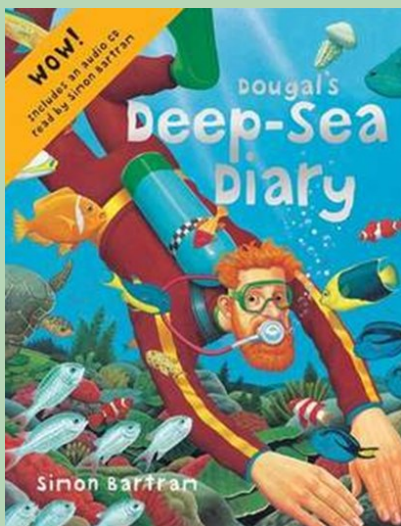
