

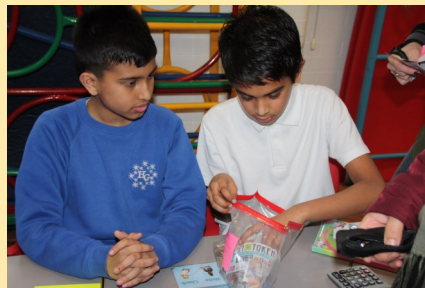


The Harry Gosling Herald

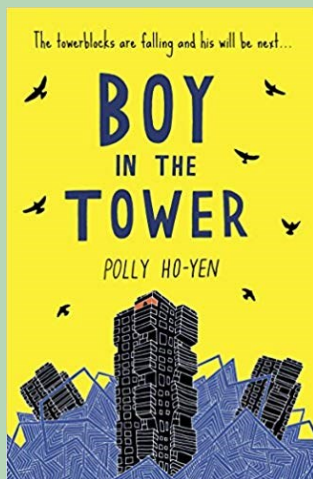
