There will be European elections on Thursday 23rd May. The school will be used as a polling station and will be closed all day to pupils.

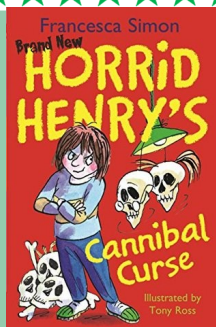
