We will need donations of prizes, bric-a-brac, food, etc. nearer the time so please start thinking about what you can do to help! More details will follow next week....



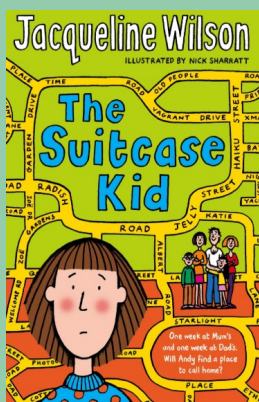
