We are also likely to be closed for EID on Monday 26th June, but we will update you nearer to the time.



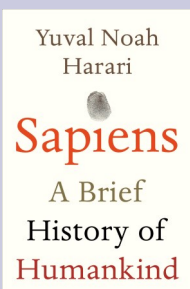
