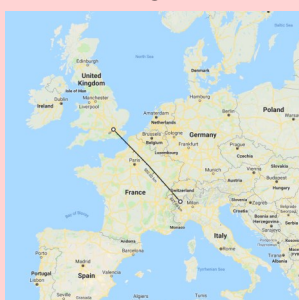

Our Sports Relief challenge is to run the 6500km that it would take to run to Rwanda in Africa. Look what progress we have made so far!



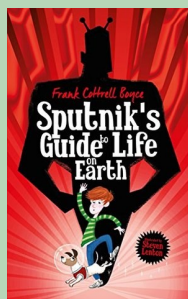
## POLLING DAY & BANK HOLIDAY

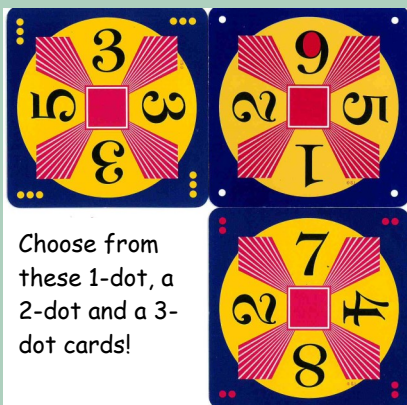
