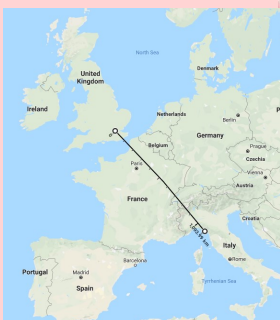
## IMPORTANT DATES!

Next Monday 7th May we are closed for the Bank Holiday.

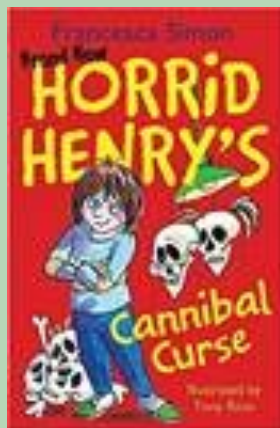

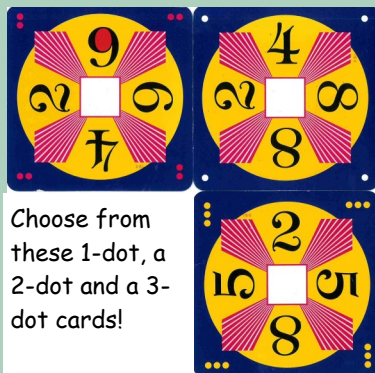
