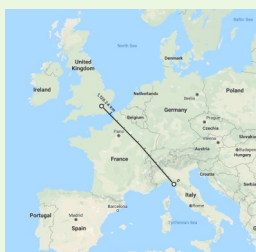
IMPORTANT DATES!

RUN TO RWANDA!

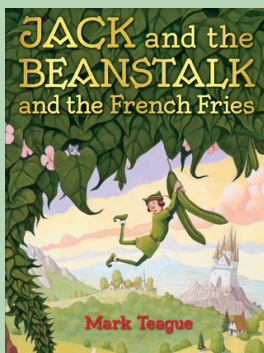

Showmik- For responsibility by doing great editing of his English work

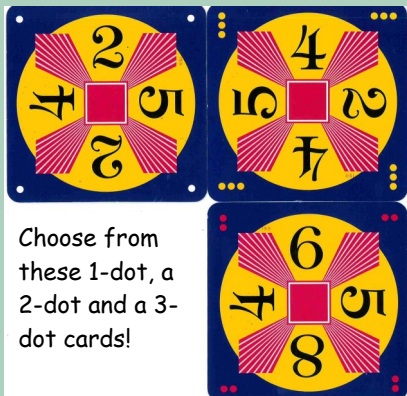
