Don't forget that we are closed next week for half term. School re-opens on Monday 3rd June.

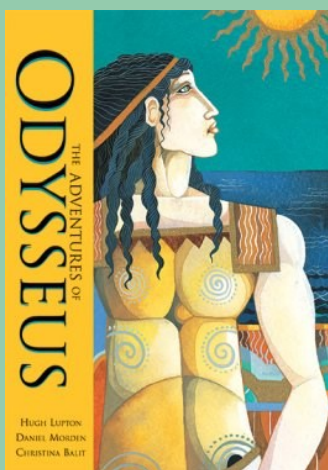
